### **Consultancy Intern at Radboudumc**

November 2016 - March 2017 (4 months)

The REVISE 2020 project aims to fundamentally change the way priorities are set in the Netherlands, and in other countries in the world. Instead of employing as central objective the maximization of population health, and using cost-effectiveness analysis to achieve this, REVISE 2020 aims to optimize legitimacy of decisions in the population, and has developed evidence-informed deliberative processes for this purpose. These processes recognize that cost-effectiveness is only input in the decision making process, and include stakeholders to account for their diverging and conflicting values.

The internship focusses on the perceived legitimacy of decisions made by the National Health Care Institute (Zorginstituut Nederland), by healthcare professionals.

### **Research Intern Gastroenterology and Hepatology at Radboudumc**

Intern at the department of Gastroenterology and Hepatology at Radboudumc, Nijmegen. The internship is focused on the efficacy of direct antiviral agents in patients with hepatitis c virus.

Goal of the internship is to perform a network meta-analysis on this rapidly advancing field of medicine.

### **Student member of the UMC-council at Radboudumc**

The UMC-council has a say in matters concerning research and education policy within the Radboud University Nijmegen Medical Centre. Topics include a focus on the future research agenda and the new bachelor's curriculum for Medicine and Biomedical Sciences. As of September 2013 student member of the executive management of the UMC-council.

### **Secretary at Landelijk Medisch Studenten Overleg (LMSO)**

January 2014 - January 2015 (1 year)

It was focused on relations between dyspepsia and lifestyle, using statistics derived from a nationwide cohort. Other activities of this internship lead to a publication as third author of an article.

### **Treasurer & Webmaster at Studenten Organisatie voor Onderwijs en Studie, UMC St. Radboud**

June 2009 - June 2011 (2 years)

The SOOS functions as a front office for (bio)medical students at the Faculty of Medical Sciences, Radboud University Nijmegen. Students address their complaints, after which SOOS forwards the complaints through the appropriate channels to the Student Council or the Educational Management Team.
